## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS REGARDING PRIHATIN SPECIAL GRANTS (GKP)

### 1. What is GKP?

GKP is a one-off financial assistance amounting to RM3,000 to micro Small and Medium Enterprises (SMEs) who are qualified. The GKP is to ease the financial burden of business while increasing productivity of production and services

### 2. Who is eligible to apply for GKP?

Meet the following requirements:

- a. Not a previous GKP recipient; and
- b. Applicants must have Malaysian citizenship status; and
- c. Applicants running Small & Medium Enterprises (SMEs) are as follows:
  - i. Total annual sales or turnover less than RM300,000; and
  - ii. The number of full-time employees does not exceed 4 people, excluding owners; and
- d. Registered with the following agencies;
  - i. Inland Revenue Board of Malaysia (IRBM) before or on 31 August 2020; or
  - ii. Local Authorities (PBT) or Companies Commission of Malaysia (SSM) before or on 31 August 2020; and
- e. Business is active during the application was made

### 3. How much is the value of GKP assistance?

The total value of GKP assistance is RM3,000 one-off.

**4. How to apply for GKP?**

Applications can be made online through the GKP Portal (<https://gkp.hasil.gov.my>) provided by the Inland Revenue Board of Malaysia.

Manual applications will not be accepted.

**5. When does the GKP application start?**

GKP application is open from **1-31 October 2020 (1 month)**.

**6. When will the results of the application be known?**

Applicants can check the results of the application starting from 15 November 2020.

**7. I am registered with government agencies (for example ROC and Local Authorities) but not registered with IRBM, am I eligible to apply for GKP 2.0?**

Eligible to apply for GKP 2.0. Applicants must fill in the business registration details on the online application form when applying.

**8. When will the GKP payment be made?**

Payment is expected to be made commencing 25 November 2020.

**9. How is the GKP payment method implemented?**

Payment will be credit to the applicant's personal bank account registered for GKP application. Bank account must be active.

**10. Will the GKP eligibility check be made with any Government Agency?**

Yes. The Government will cross-check with several Government Agencies to ensure the authenticity of the information submitted by the applicants.
